- 20 And how the chief priests and our rulers delivered him to be condemned to death, and have crucified him.
- But we trusted that it had been he which should have redeemed Israel: and beside all this, to-day is the third day since these things were done.

- Then he said unto them, O fools, and slow of heart to believe all that the prophets have spoken:
- Ought not Christ to have suffered these things, and to enter into his glory?
- And beginning at Moses and all the prophets, he expounded unto them in all the scriptures the things concerning himself.
- And it came to pass, as he sat at meat with them, he took bread, and blessed *it*, and brake, and gave to them.
- 31 And their eyes were opened, and they knew him; and he vanished out of their sight.
- And they said one to another, Did not our heart burn within us, while he talked with us by the way, and while he opened to us the scriptures?
