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- The Bible

Jer. 23:1, 2 (to Israel), 3-6 1st I

- 1 WOE be unto the pastors that destroy and scatter the sheep of my pasture! saith the LORD.
- 2 Therefore thus saith the LORD God of Israel
- 3 I will gather the remnant of my flock out of all countries whither I have driven them, and will bring them again to their folds; and they shall be fruitful and increase.
- 4 And I will set up shepherds over them which shall feed them: and they shall fear no more, nor be dismayed, neither shall they be lacking, saith the LORD.
- 5 ¶ Behold, the days come, saith the LORD, that I will raise unto David a righteous Branch, and a King shall reign and prosper, and shall execute judgment and justice in the earth.
- 6 In his days Judah shall be saved, and Israel shall dwell safely: and this *is* his name whereby he shall be called, THE LORD OUR RIGHTEOUSNESS.

- 3 Grace *be* to you and peace from God the Father, and *from* our Lord Jesus Christ,
- 4 Who gave himself for our sins, that he might deliver us from this present evil world, according to the will of God and our Father:
- 5 To whom *be* glory for ever and ever.

Matt. 8:2, 3, 5-8, 13-18, 23-27

- 2 And, behold, there came a leper and worshipped him, saying, Lord, if thou wilt, thou canst make me clean.
- 3 And Jesus put forth *his* hand, and touched him, saying, I will; be thou clean. And immediately his leprosy was cleansed.
- 5 ¶ And when Jesus was entered into Capernaum, there came unto him a centurion, beseeching him,
- 6 And saying, Lord, my servant lieth at home sick of the palsy, grievously tormented.
- 7 And Jesus saith unto him, I will come and heal him.
- 8 The centurion answered and said, Lord, I am not worthy that thou shouldest come under my roof: but speak the word only, and my servant shall be healed.
- 13 And Jesus said unto the centurion, Go thy way; and as thou hast believed, *so* be it done unto thee. And his servant was healed in the selfsame hour.

- 14 ¶ And when Jesus was come into Peter's house, he saw his wife's mother laid, and sick of a fever.
- 15 And he touched her hand, and the fever left her: and she arose, and ministered unto them.
- 16 ¶ When the even was come, they brought unto him many that were possessed with devils: and he cast out the spirits with *his* word, and healed all that were sick:
- 17 That it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Esaias the prophet, saying, Himself took our infirmities, and bare *our* sicknesses.
- 18 ¶ Now when Jesus saw great multitudes about him, he gave commandment to depart unto the other side.
- 23 ¶ And when he was entered into a ship, his disciples followed him.
- 24 And, behold, there arose a great tempest in the sea, insomuch that the ship was covered with the waves: but he was asleep.
- 25 And his disciples came to *him*, and awoke him, saying, Lord, save us: we perish.
- 26 And he saith unto them, Why are ye fearful, O ye of little faith? Then he arose, and rebuked the winds and the sea; and there was a great calm.
- 27 But the men marvelled, saying, What manner of man is this, that even the winds and the sea obey him!

John 5:17, 30

- 17 ¶ But Jesus answered them, My Father worketh hitherto, and I work.
- 30 I can of mine own self do nothing: as I hear, I judge: and my judgment is just; because I seek not mine own will, but the will of the Father which hath sent me.

Isa. 25:1, 4, 7-9

- 1 O LORD, thou *art* my God; I will exalt thee, I will praise thy name; for thou hast done wonderful *things*; *thy* counsels of old *are* faithfulness *and* truth.
- 4 For thou hast been a strength to the poor, a strength to the needy in his distress, a refuge from the storm, a shadow from the heat, when the blast of the terrible ones *is* as a storm *against* the wall.
- 7 And he will destroy in this mountain the face of the covering cast over all people, and the veil that is spread over all nations.
- 8 He will swallow up death in victory; and the Lord GOD will wipe away tears from off all faces; and the rebuke of his people shall he take away from off all the earth: for the LORD hath spoken *it*.
- 9 ¶ And it shall be said in that day, Lo, this *is* our God; we have waited for him, and he will save us: this *is* the LORD; we have waited for him, we will be glad and rejoice in his salvation.

SH 107:1-14

107:1 In the year 1866, I discovered the Christ Science or  
divine laws of Life, Truth, and Love, and  
3 named my discovery Christian Science. God  
had been graciously preparing me during many  
years for the reception of this final revelation of the ab-  
6 solute divine Principle of scientific mental healing.

This apodictical Principle points to the revelation of  
Immanuel, “God with us,” — the sovereign ever-pres-  
9 ence, delivering the children of men from  
every ill “that flesh is heir to.” Through  
Christian Science, religion and medicine are  
12 inspired with a diviner nature and essence; fresh pinions  
are given to faith and understanding, and thoughts ac-  
quaint themselves intelligently with God.

SH 226:25-13, 21-24 (np)

The lame, the deaf, the dumb, the blind, the sick, the  
sensual, the sinner, I wished to save from the slavery of  
27 their own beliefs and from the educational  
systems of the Pharaohs, who to-day, as of  
yore, hold the children of Israel in bondage. I saw be-  
30 fore me the awful conflict, the Red Sea and the wilder-  
ness; but I pressed on through faith in God, trusting  
Truth, the strong deliverer, to guide me into the land  
227:1 of Christian Science, where fetters fall and the rights of  
man are fully known and acknowledged.

3 I saw that the law of mortal belief included all error,  
and that, even as oppressive laws are disputed and mor-  
tals are taught their right to freedom, so the  
6 claims of the enslaving senses must be de-  
nied and superseded. The law of the divine Mind must  
end human bondage, or mortals will continue unaware  
9 of man’s inalienable rights and in subjection to hope-  
less slavery, because some public teachers permit  
an ignorance of divine power, — an ignorance that  
12 is the foundation of continued bondage and of human  
suffering.

21 Christian Science raises the standard of liberty and  
cries: “Follow me! Escape from the bondage of sick-  
ness, sin, and death!” Jesus marked out the  
24 way. Citizens of the world, accept the “glori-  
ous liberty of the children of God,” and be free! This

is your divine right. The illusion of material sense, not  
27 divine law, has bound you, entangled your free limbs,  
crippled your capacities, enfeebled your body, and de-  
faced the tablet of your being.

30 If God had instituted material laws to govern man,  
disobedience to which would have made man ill, Jesus  
would not have disregarded those laws by healing in  
228:1 direct opposition to them and in defiance of all material  
conditions.

3 The transmission of disease or of certain idiosyncra-  
sies of mortal mind would be impossible if this great fact  
of being were learned, — namely, that nothing  
6 inharmonious can enter being, for Life *is* God.  
Heredity is a prolific subject for mortal belief to pin the-  
ories upon; but if we learn that nothing is real but the  
9 right, we shall have no dangerous inheritances, and fleshly  
ills will disappear.

The enslavement of man is not legitimate. It will  
12 cease when man enters into his heritage of freedom, his  
God-given dominion over the material senses.  
Mortals will some day assert their freedom in  
15 the name of Almighty God. Then they will control their  
own bodies through the understanding of divine Science.  
Dropping their present beliefs, they will recognize har-  
mony as the spiritual reality and discord as the material  
18 unreality.

If we follow the command of our Master, “Take no  
21 thought for your life,” we shall never depend on bodily  
conditions, structure, or economy, but we shall be masters  
of the body, dictate its terms, and form and control it with  
24 Truth.

Rise in the conscious strength of the  
391:1 spirit of Truth to overthrow the plea of mortal mind,  
*alias* matter, arrayed against the supremacy of Spirit.  
3 Blot out the images of mortal thought and its beliefs in  
sickness and sin. Then, when thou art delivered to the  
judgment of Truth, Christ, the judge will say, “Thou  
6 art whole!”

In the following Psalm one word shows, though faintly,  
578:1 the light which Christian Science throws on the Scriptures  
by substituting for the corporeal sense, the incorporeal  
3 or spiritual sense of Deity: —

PSALM XXIII

[DIVINE LOVE] is my shepherd; I shall not want.  
6 [LOVE] maketh me to lie down in green pastures:  
[LOVE] leadeth me beside the still waters.  
[LOVE] restoreth my soul [spiritual sense]: [LOVE] lead-  
9 eth me in the paths of righteousness for His name's sake.  
Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of  
death, I will fear no evil: for [LOVE] is with me; [LOVE's]  
12 rod and [LOVE's] staff they comfort me.  
[LOVE] prepareth a table before me in the presence of  
mine enemies: [LOVE] anointeth my head with oil; my cup  
15 runneth over.  
Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of  
my life; and I will dwell in the house [the consciousness]  
18 of [LOVE] for ever.
