- ²⁹ There were therefore seven brethren: and the first took a wife, and died without children.
- 30 And the second took her to wife, and he died childless.
- ³¹ And the third took her; and in like manner the seven also: and they left no children, and died.
- 32 Last of all the woman died also.
- ³³ Therefore in the resurrection whose wife of them is she? for seven had her to wife.
- ³⁴ And Jesus answering said unto them, The children of this world marry, and are given in marriage:
- ³⁵ But they which shall be accounted worthy to obtain that world, and the resurrection from the dead, neither marry, nor are given in marriage:
- ³⁶ Neither can they die any more: for they are equal unto the angels; and are the children of God,
- ³⁸ For he is not a God of the dead, but of the living: for all live unto him.
