## Scriptural selection

### 1. Ex. 9:1 the

1 ...the LORD said unto Moses, Go in unto Pharaoh, and tell him,  
Thus saith the LORD God of the Hebrews, Let my people go, that  
they may serve me.

### 2. Ex. 13:17 (to 2nd ), 18 God (to :), 21 (to 2nd ); 14:9 (to ), 10, 13, 14, 19–23 (to them), 26 (to again), 27 (to ;), 28, 30 (to ;)

- 17 ¶ And it came to pass, when Pharaoh had let the people go,  
18 ...God led the people about, *through* the way of the wilderness of  
the Red sea:  
21 And the LORD went before them by day in a pillar of a cloud, to  
lead them the way; and by night in a pillar of fire, to give them  
light;  
9 But the Egyptians pursued after them,  
10 ¶ And when Pharaoh drew nigh, the children of Israel lifted up  
their eyes, and, behold, the Egyptians marched after them; and  
they were sore afraid: and the children of Israel cried out unto the  
LORD.  
13 ¶ And Moses said unto the people, Fear ye not, stand still, and see  
the salvation of the LORD, which he will shew to you to-day: for  
the Egyptians whom ye have seen to-day, ye shall see them again  
no more for ever.  
14 The LORD shall fight for you, and ye shall hold your peace.  
19 ¶ And the angel of God, which went before the camp of Israel,

removed and went behind them; and the pillar of the cloud went from before their face, and stood behind them:

20 And it came between the camp of the Egyptians and the camp of Israel; and it was a cloud and darkness *to them*, but it gave light by night *to these*: so that the one came not near the other all the night.

21 And Moses stretched out his hand over the sea; and the LORD caused the sea to go *back* by a strong east wind all that night, and made the sea dry *land*, and the waters were divided.

22 And the children of Israel went into the midst of the sea upon the dry *ground*: and the waters *were* a wall unto them on their right hand, and on their left.

23 ¶ And the Egyptians pursued, and went in after them

26 ¶ And the LORD said unto Moses, Stretch out thine hand over the sea, that the waters may come again

27 And Moses stretched forth his hand over the sea, and the sea returned to his strength when the morning appeared;

28 And the waters returned, and covered the chariots, and the horsemen, *and* all the host of Pharaoh that came into the sea after them; there remained not so much as one of them.

30 Thus the LORD saved Israel that day out of the hand of the Egyptians;
