Scriptural selection

1. Deut. 12:10-12 when (to;), 13, 14

- 10 ... when ye go over Jordan, and dwell in the land which the Lord your God giveth you to inherit, and when he giveth you rest from all your enemies round about, so that ye dwell in safety;
- 11 Then there shall be a place which the LORD your God shall choose to cause his name to dwell there; thither shall ye bring all that I command you; your burnt offerings, and your sacrifices, your tithes, and the heave offering of your hand, and all your choice vows which ye vow unto the LORD:
- 12 And ye shall rejoice before the LORD your God, ye, and your sons, and your daughters, and your menservants, and your maidservants, and the Levite that *is* within your gates;
- 13 Take heed to thyself that thou offer not thy burnt offerings in every place that thou seest:
- 14 But in the place which the LORD shall choose in one of thy tribes, there thou shalt offer thy burnt offerings, and there thou shalt do all that I command thee.

2. Ps. 144:3, 4, 11, 12, 15

- 3 Lord, what *is* man, that thou takest knowledge of him! *or* the son of man, that thou makest account of him!
- 4 Man is like to vanity: his days *are* as a shadow that passeth away.
- Rid me, and deliver me from the hand of strange children, whose mouth speaketh vanity, and their right hand *is* a right hand of falsehood:
- 12 That our sons *may be* as plants grown up in their youth; *that* our daughters *may be* as corner stones, polished *after* the similitude of a palace:
- 15 Happy *is that* people, that is in such a case: *yea*, happy *is that* people, whose God *is* the LORD.
