Scriptural selection

1. Ps. 51:10–12

- 10 Create in me a clean heart, O God; and renew a right spirit within me.
- 11 Cast me not away from thy presence; and take not thy holy spirit from me.
- 12 Restore unto me the joy of thy salvation; and uphold me *with thy* free spirit.

2. Rom. 11:1 (to 1st .)

- 1 I say then, Hath God cast away his people? God forbid. ...

3. Job 36:2–7, 11, 24, 25

- 2 Suffer me a little, and I will shew thee that *I have* yet to speak on God's behalf.
- 3 I will fetch my knowledge from afar, and will ascribe righteousness to my Maker.
- 4 For truly my words *shall* not *be* false: he that is perfect in knowledge *is* with thee.
- 5 Behold, God *is* mighty, and despiseth not *any*: *he is* mighty in strength *and* wisdom.
- 6 He preserveth not the life of the wicked: but giveth right to the poor.
- 7 He withdraweth not his eyes from the righteous: but with kings *are they* on the throne; yea, he doth establish them for ever, and they

are exalted.

- 11 If they obey and serve *him*, they shall spend their days in prosperity, and their years in pleasures.
- 24 Remember that thou magnify his work, which men behold.
- 25 Every man may see it; man may behold *it* afar off.

4. Ps. 34:2, 3

- 2 My soul shall make her boast in the LORD: the humble shall hear *thereof*, and be glad.
- 3 O magnify the LORD with me, and let us exalt his name together.
