Scriptural Selection

1. Dan 2:20 Blessed, 21 he giveth, 22
 - 20 Blessed be the name of God for ever and ever: for wisdom and might are his:
 - 21 he giveth wisdom unto the wise, and knowledge to them that know understanding:
 - 22 He revealeth the deep and secret things: he knoweth what *is* in the darkness, and the light dwelleth with him.

2. I Sam 9:3-6 the, 10, 15-20 (to .)
 - 3 the asses of Kish Saul's father were lost. And Kish said to Saul his son, Take now one of the servants with thee, and arise, go seek the asses.
 - 4 And he passed through mount Ephraim, and passed through the land of Shalisha, but they found *them* not: then they passed through the land of Shalim, and *there they were* not: and he passed through the land of the Benjamites, but they found *them* not.
 - 5 *And* when they were come to the land of Zuph, Saul said to his servant that *was* with him, Come, and let us return; lest my father leave *caring* for the asses, and take thought for us.
 - 6 And he said unto him, Behold now, *there is* in this city a man of God, and *he is* an honourable man; all that he saith cometh surely to pass: now let us go thither; peradventure he can shew us our way that we should go.
 - 10 Then said Saul to his servant, Well said; come, let us go. So they went unto the city where the man of God *was*.
 - 15 ¶ Now the LORD had told Samuel in his ear a day before Saul came, saying,
 - 16 To-morrow about this time I will send thee a man out of the land of Benjamin, and thou shalt anoint him *to be* captain over my people Israel, that he may save my people out of the hand of the Philistines: for I have looked upon my people, because their cry is come unto me.
 - 17 And when Samuel saw Saul, the LORD said unto him, Behold the man whom I spake to thee of! this same shall reign over my people.
 - 18 Then Saul drew near to Samuel in the gate, and said, Tell me, I pray thee, where the seer's house *is*.
 - 19 And Samuel answered Saul, and said, I *am* the seer: go up before me unto the high place; for ye shall eat with me to-day, and to-morrow I will let thee go, and will tell thee all that *is* in thine heart.
 - 20 And as for thine asses that were lost three days ago, set not thy mind on them; for they are found.

- 6 In all thy ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct thy paths.
