Scriptural Selection

1. Job 7:17, 18

- 17 What *is* man, that thou shouldest magnify him? and that thou shouldest set thine heart upon him?
- 18 And *that* thou shouldest visit him every morning, *and* try him every moment?

2. Ps. 8:5-9

- 5 For thou hast made him a little lower than the angels, and hast crowned him with glory and honour.
- 6 Thou madest him to have dominion over the works of thy hands; thou hast put all *things* under his feet:
- 7 All sheep and oxen, yea, and the beasts of the field;
- 8 The fowl of the air, and the fish of the sea, *and whatsoever* passeth through the paths of the seas.

3. Ps 89:15-17

- 16 In thy name shall they rejoice all the day: and in thy righteousness shall they be exalted.
- 17 For thou *art* the glory of their strength: and in thy favour our horn shall be exalted.

4. Ps 75:10

- 10 All the horns of the wicked also will I cut off; *but* the horns of the righteous shall be exalted.

5. Ps 18:1, 2, 17, 18, 29-32

- 1 I WILL love thee, O LORD, my strength.
- 2 The LORD *is* my rock, and my fortress, and my deliverer; my God, my strength, in whom I will trust; my buckler, and the horn of my salvation, *and* my high tower.
- 17 He delivered me from my strong enemy, and from them which hated me: for they were too strong for me.
- 18 They prevented me in the day of my calamity: but the LORD was my stay.

- 29 For by thee I have run through a troop; and by my God have I leaped over a wall.
- 30 *As for* God, his way *is* perfect: the word of the LORD is tried: he *is* a buckler to all those that trust in him.
- 31 For who *is* God save the LORD? or who *is* a rock save our God?
- 32 *It is* God that girdeth me with strength, and maketh my way perfect.

6. Ps 29:1, 2, 11

- 1 GIVE unto the LORD, O ye mighty, give unto the LORD glory and strength.
- 2 Give unto the LORD the glory due unto his name; worship the LORD in the beauty of holiness.
- 11 The LORD will give strength unto his people; the LORD will bless his people with peace.
