- 13 Fulfil your works, your daily tasks,

30 stand every morning to thank and praise the LORD, and likewise at even;

3. Ps 92:1, 2

- 1 *IT is a* good *thing* to give thanks unto the LORD, and to sing praises unto thy name, O most High:
- 2 To shew forth thy lovingkindness in the morning, and thy faithfulness every night,

8 So will I sing praise unto thy name for ever, that I may daily perform my vows.

12. I Chron. 16:1 the, 2, 4, 23, 36, 37

- 1 the ark of God, and set it in the midst of the tent that David had pitched for it: and they offered burnt sacrifices and peace offerings before God.
- 2 And when David had made an end of offering the burnt offerings and the peace offerings, he blessed the people in the name of the LORD.
- ⁴ ¶ And he appointed *certain* of the Levites to minister before the ark of the LORD, and to record, and to thank and praise the LORD God of Israel:

- ³⁶ Therefore let all the house of Israel know assuredly, that God hath made that same Jesus, whom ye have crucified, both Lord and Christ.
- 37 ¶ Now when they heard *this*, they were pricked in their heart, and said unto Peter and to the rest of the apostles, Men *and* brethren, what shall we do?
- 38 Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost.
- 41 ¶ Then they that gladly received his word were baptized: and the same day there were added *unto them* about three thousand souls.
- 42 And they continued stedfastly in the apostles' doctrine and fellowship, and in breaking of bread, and in prayers.
- 46 And they, continuing daily with one accord in the temple, and breaking bread from house to house, did eat their meat with gladness and singleness of heart,
- 47 Praising God, and having favour with all the people. And the Lord added to the church daily such as should be saved.

1 Now Peter and John went up together into the temple at the hour of prayer, *being* the ninth *hour*.

- 2 And a certain man lame from his mother's womb was carried, whom they laid daily at the gate of the temple which is called Beautiful, to ask alms of them that entered into the temple;
- ³ Who seeing Peter and John about to go into the temple asked an alms.
- ⁶ Then Peter said, Silver and gold have I none; but such as I have give I thee: In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth rise up and walk.
- 7 And he took him by the right hand, and lifted *him* up: and immediately his feet and ankle bones received strength.
- 8 And he leaping up stood, and walked, and entered with them into the temple, walking, and leaping, and praising God.
- 9 And all the people saw him walking and praising God:

21. Heb. 3:12-14

- 12 Take heed, brethren, lest there be in any of you an evil heart of unbelief, in departing from the living God.
- 13 But exhort one another daily, while it is called To-day; lest any of you be hardened through the deceitfulness of sin.

- 21 the divine character, will mould and fashion us anew, until we awake in His likeness.

Truth

- 143:1 is God's remedy for error of every kind, and Truth destroys only what is untrue. Hence the fact that, to-day,
- ³ as yesterday, Christ casts out evils and heals the sick.

5. SH 142:18-20

As in Jesus' time, so to-day, tyranny and pride need to be whipped out of the temple, and humility and divine Science to be welcomed in.

6. SH 254:19

But the human self must be evangel-

ized. This task God demands us to accept lovingly

21 to-day, and to abandon so fast as practical the material, and to work out the spiritual which determines the outward and actual.

12. SH 25:3-9

- ³ The spiritual essence of blood is sacrifice. The efficacy of Jesus' spiritual offering is infinitely greater than can be expressed by our sense of human
- 6 blood. The material blood of Jesus was no more efficacious to cleanse from sin when it was shed upon "the accursed tree," than when it was flowing in
- 9 his veins as he went daily about his Father's business.

13. SH 31:12-17, 25-28

- ¹² First in the list of Christian duties, he taught his followers the healing power of Truth and Love. He attached no importance to dead ceremonies. It is the
- 15 living Christ, the practical Truth, which makes Jesus "the resurrection and the life" to all who follow him in deed.

Referring to the materiality of the age, Jesus said: "The hour cometh, and now is, when the true wor-

27 shippers shall worship the Father in spirit and in truth."

14. SH 40:25-10

Our heavenly Father, divine Love, demands that all men should follow the example of our Master and his

apostles and not merely worship his personality. It is sad that the phrase *divine service*has come so generally to mean public worship instead of
daily deeds.

The nature of Christianity is peaceful and blessed, but in order to enter into the kingdom, the anchor of

- 41:1 hope must be cast beyond the veil of matter into the Shekinah into which Jesus has passed before us; and
- this advance beyond matter must come through the joys and triumphs of the righteous as well as through their sorrows and afflictions.
- 6 Like our Master, we must depart from material sense into the spiritual sense of being.

The God-inspired walk calmly on though it be with

9 bleeding footprints, and in the hereafter they will reap what they now sow.

15. SH 283:27-31

We must receive the divine Principle in the understanding, and live it in daily life; and unless we so do, we True flesh and blood

 The Hebrew verb *to believe* means also *to be firm* or
- 24:1 *to be constant*. This certainly applies to Truth and Love understood and practised.

27 turning daily on its own axis.

As thus indicated, astronomical order imitates the action of divine Principle; and the universe, the reflec-

- 30 tion of God, is thus brought nearer the spiritual fact, and is allied to divine Science as displayed in the everlasting government of the universe.

Whoever reaches the understanding of Christian Science 179:1 in its proper signification will perform the sudden cures of which it is capable; but this can be done only by

taking up the cross and following Christ in the daily life.

- 21:1 If Truth is overcoming error in your daily walk and conversation, you can finally say, "I have fought a
- ³ good fight . . . I have kept the faith," because you are a better man.
- 9 If the disciple is advancing spiritually, he is striving to enter in. He constantly turns away from material sense, and looks towards the imperishable things
- ¹² of Spirit. If honest, he will be in earnest from the start, and gain a little each day in the right direction,
