1. Ps. 119:45 1st I

45 I will walk at liberty: for I seek thy precepts.

# Science and Health with Key to the Scriptures by Mary Baker Eddy

### 1. SH 481:4

"Where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty." Like the archpriests of yore, man is 6 free "to enter into the holiest," — the realm of God.

## 2. SH 475:28-31

Man is incapable of sin, sickness, and death. The real man cannot depart from holiness, nor

30 can God, by whom man is evolved, engender the capacity or freedom to sin.

#### 3. SH 225:29-31

Men and women of all climes and races are still in bondage to material sense, ignorant how to obtain their freedom.

#### 4. SH 227:3, 16-26

- I saw that the law of mortal belief included all error, and that, even as oppressive laws are disputed and mortals are taught their right to freedom, so the
- 6 claims of the enslaving senses must be denied and superseded. The law of the divine Mind must end human bondage, or mortals will continue unaware
- 9 of man's inalienable rights and in subjection to hopeless slavery, because some public teachers permit an ignorance of divine power, — an ignorance that
- 12 is the foundation of continued bondage and of human suffering.

God made man free.

Paul said, "I was free born." All men should

- 18 be free. "Where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty." Love and Truth make free, but evil and error lead into captivity.
- 21 Christian Science raises the standard of liberty and cries: "Follow me! Escape from the bondage of sickness, sin, and death!" Jesus marked out the
- 24 way. Citizens of the world, accept the "glorious liberty of the children of God," and be free! This is your divine right.

### 5. SH 228:3-16

- <sup>3</sup> The transmission of disease or of certain idiosyncrasies of mortal mind would be impossible if this great fact of being were learned, — namely, that nothing
- inharmonious can enter being, for Life *is* God.
  Heredity is a prolific subject for mortal belief to pin theories upon; but if we learn that nothing is real but the
- 9 right, we shall have no dangerous inheritances, and fleshly ills will disappear.

- tal, not physical. It lifts the veil of mystery from Soul and body. It shows the scientific relation of man to God, disentangles the interlaced ambiguities
- of being, and sets free the imprisoned thought.

## 15. SH 161:11

In 1880, Massachusetts put her foot on a proposed

- 12 tyrannical law, restricting the practice of medicine. If her sister States follow this example in harmony with our Constitution and Bill of Rights,
- they will do less violence to that immortal sentiment of the Declaration, "Man is endowed by his Maker with certain inalienable rights, among which are life, liberty, and the
- 18 pursuit of happiness."
