## The Bible

### 1. Ps. 119:45 1st I

45 I will walk at liberty: for I seek thy precepts.

### 2. Isa. 61:1

1 THE spirit of the Lord GOD *is* upon me; because the LORD hath anointed me to preach good tidings unto the meek; he hath sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to *them that are* bound;

### 3. Acts 22:28 2nd I

28 I was *free* born.

### 4. John 9:1-3 as, 5, 7

1 as *Jesus* passed by, he saw a man which was blind from *his* birth.  
2 And his disciples asked him, saying, Master, who did sin, this man, or his parents, that he was born blind?  
3 Jesus answered, Neither hath this man sinned, nor his parents: but that the works of God should be made manifest in him.  
5 As long as I am in the world, I am the light of the world.  
7 And said unto him, Go, wash in the pool of Siloam, (which is by interpretation, Sent.) He went his way therefore, and washed, and came seeing.

### 5. Matt 8:1-4, 14-17

1 WHEN he was come down from the mountain, great multitudes followed him.  
2 And, behold, there came a leper and worshipped him, saying, Lord, if thou wilt, thou canst make me clean.  
3 And Jesus put forth *his* hand, and touched him, saying, I will; be thou clean. And immediately his leprosy was cleansed.

16 ¶ When the even was come, they brought unto him many that were possessed with devils: and he cast out the spirits with *his* word, and healed

- 13 For by one Spirit are we all baptized into one body, whether *we be* Jews or Gentiles, whether *we be* bond or free; and have been all made to drink into one Spirit.

- 24 ¶ And when they were come to Capernaum, they that received tribute *money* came to Peter, and said, Doth not your master pay tribute?

- 6 *Is* not this the fast that I have chosen? to loose the bands of wickedness, to undo the heavy burdens, and to let the oppressed go free, and that ye break every yoke?

9. Matt 9:32, 33, 35

- 32 ¶ As they went out, behold, they brought to him a dumb man possessed with a devil.
- 33 And when the devil was cast out, the dumb spake: and the multitudes marvelled, saying, It was never so seen in Israel.
- 35 And Jesus went about all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing every sickness and every disease among the people.

10. Jer. 29:14 2nd I (to ;)

- 14 I will turn away your captivity, and I will gather you from all the nations, and from all the places whither I have driven you, saith the LORD;

11. Jer. 34:8, 15 (to ;)

- 8 ¶ *This is* the word that came unto Jeremiah from the LORD, after that the king Zedekiah had made a covenant with all the people which *were* at Jerusalem, to proclaim liberty unto them;

15 And ye were now turned, and had done right in my sight, in proclaiming liberty every man to his neighbour;

12. John 8:31-36 Jesus

31 Jesus to those Jews which believed on him, If ye continue in my word, *then* are ye my disciples indeed;

32 And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free.

33 ¶ They answered him, We be Abraham's seed, and were never in bondage to any man: how sayest thou, Ye shall be made free?

34 Jesus answered them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Whosoever committeth sin is the servant of sin.

35 And the servant abideth not in the house for ever: *but* the Son abideth ever.

36 If the Son therefore shall make you free, ye shall be free indeed.

13. Gal. 4:26 Jerusalem, 31 brethren

26 Jerusalem which is above is free, which is the mother of us all.

31 brethren, we are not children of the bondwoman, but of the free.

14. Gal. 5:1, 13

1 STAND fast therefore in the liberty wherewith Christ hath made us free, and be not entangled again with the yoke of bondage.

13 For, brethren, ye have been called unto liberty; only *use* not liberty for an occasion to the flesh, but by love serve one another.

15. James 1:25 whoso

25 whoso looketh into the perfect law of liberty, and continueth *therein*, he being not a forgetful hearer, but a doer of the work, this man shall be blessed in his deed.

16. James 2:12

12 So speak ye, and so do, as they that shall be judged by the law of liberty.

17. Rom. 8:2

2 For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus hath made me free from the law of sin and death.

**Science and Health with Key to the Scriptures by Mary Baker Eddy**

1. SH 481:4

“Where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty.” Like the archpriests of yore, man is

6 free “to enter into the holiest,” — the realm of God.

## 2. SH 475:28-31

Man is incapable of sin, sickness, and death. The real man cannot depart from holiness, nor can God, by whom man is evolved, engender the capacity or freedom to sin.

## 3. SH 225:29-31

Men and women of all climes and races are still in bondage to material sense, ignorant how to obtain their freedom.

## 4. SH 227:3, 16-26

I saw that the law of mortal belief included all error, and that, even as oppressive laws are disputed and mortals are taught their right to freedom, so the claims of the enslaving senses must be denied and superseded. The law of the divine Mind must end human bondage, or mortals will continue unaware of man’s inalienable rights and in subjection to hopeless slavery, because some public teachers permit an ignorance of divine power, — an ignorance that is the foundation of continued bondage and of human suffering.

God made man free.

Paul said, “I was free born.” All men should be free. “Where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty.” Love and Truth make free, but evil and error lead into captivity.

Christian Science raises the standard of liberty and cries: “Follow me! Escape from the bondage of sickness, sin, and death!” Jesus marked out the way. Citizens of the world, accept the “glorious liberty of the children of God,” and be free! This is your divine right.

## 5. SH 228:3-16

The transmission of disease or of certain idiosyncrasies of mortal mind would be impossible if this great fact of being were learned, — namely, that nothing inharmonious can enter being, for Life *is* God.

Heredity is a prolific subject for mortal belief to pin theories upon; but if we learn that nothing is real but the right, we shall have no dangerous inheritances, and fleshly ills will disappear.

#### 6. SH 178:22-27

In pro-  
 portion to our understanding of Christian Science, we are  
 24 freed from the belief of heredity, of mind in matter or ani-  
 mal magnetism; and we disarm sin of its imaginary power  
 in proportion to our spiritual understanding of the status  
 27 of immortal being.

#### 7. SH 191:16

The human thought must free itself from self-imposed  
 materiality and bondage. It should no longer  
 18 ask of the head, heart, or lungs: What are  
 man's prospects for life? Mind is not helpless. Intelli-  
 gence is not mute before non-intelligence.

3 In order to cure his patient, the metaphysician  
 must first cast moral evils out of himself and thus

 9 and hinders him from reaching his patient's thought, —

 it is freed from the material body, spirit retains the sensa-  
 tions belonging to that body.

 to God, disentangles the interlaced ambiguities  
 27 of being, and sets free the imprisoned thought.

In 1880, Massachusetts put her foot on a proposed  
 12 tyrannical law, restricting the practice of medicine. If  
 her sister States follow this example in har-  
 mony with our Constitution and Bill of Rights,  
 15 they will do less violence to that immortal sentiment of the  
 Declaration, "Man is endowed by his Maker with certain  
 inalienable rights, among which are life, liberty, and the  
 18 pursuit of happiness."

versal freedom, asking a fuller acknowledg-  
9 ment of the rights of man as a Son of God, demanding  
that the fetters of sin, sickness, and death be stricken  
from the human mind and that its freedom be won, not  
12 through human warfare, not with bayonet and blood, but  
through Christ's divine Science.
