Scriptural Selection

1. Prov. 3:1-6, 12-26

- 1 MY son, forget not my law; but let thine heart keep my commandments;
- 2 For length of days, and long life, and peace, shall they add to thee.
- 3 Let not mercy and truth forsake thee: bind them about thy neck; write them upon the table of thine heart:
- 4 So shalt thou find favour and good understanding in the sight of God and man.
- 5 ¶ Trust in the LORD with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding.
- 6 In all thy ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct thy paths.
- 12 For whom the LORD loveth he correcteth; even as a father the son *in whom* he delighteth.
- 13 ¶ Happy *is* the man *that* findeth wisdom, and the man *that* getteth understanding.
- 14 For the merchandise of it *is* better than the merchandise of silver, and the gain thereof than fine gold.
- 15 She *is* more precious than rubies: and all the things thou canst desire are not to be compared unto her.

- 20 By his knowledge the depths are broken up, and the clouds drop down the
 dew.
- 21 ¶ My son, let not them depart from thine eyes: keep sound wisdom and
 discretion:
- 22 So shall they be life unto thy soul, and grace to thy neck.
- 23 Then shalt thou walk in thy way safely, and thy foot shall not stumble.
- 24 When thou liest down, thou shalt not be afraid: yea, thou shalt lie down,
 and thy sleep shall be sweet.
- 25 Be not afraid of sudden fear, neither of the desolation of the wicked, when
 it cometh.
- 26 For the LORD shall be thy confidence, and shall keep thy foot from being
 taken.
2. Prov. 4:5 (to ;), 6, 7
- 5 Get wisdom, get understanding: forget *it* not;
- 6 Forsake her not, and she shall preserve thee: love her, and she shall keep
 thee.
- 7 Wisdom *is* the principal thing; *therefore* get wisdom: and with all thy
 getting get understanding.
