Scriptural Selection

- 1. Eph 3:14-19 I bow
- 14 I bow my knees unto the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ,
- 15 Of whom the whole family in heaven and earth is named,
- That he would grant you, according to the riches of his glory, to be strengthened with might by his Spirit in the inner man;
- 17 That Christ may dwell in your hearts by faith; that ye, being rooted and grounded in love,
- May be able to comprehend with all saints what *is* the breadth, and length, and depth, and height;
- 19 And to know the love of Christ, which passeth knowledge, that ye might be filled with all the fulness of God.

- ¶ The next day John seeth Jesus coming unto him, and saith, Behold the Lamb of God, which taketh away the sin of the world.
- And John bare record, saying, I saw the Spirit descending from heaven like a dove, and it abode upon him.
- 33 And I knew him not: but he that sent me to baptize with water, the same said unto me, Upon whom thou shalt see the Spirit descending, and remaining on him, the same is he which baptizeth with the Holy Ghost.
- 34 And I saw, and bare record that this is the Son of God.
- 35 ¶ Again the next day after John stood, and two of his disciples;

- 36 And looking upon Jesus as he walked, he saith, Behold the Lamb of God!
- 4. Acts 10:38 God
- God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power: who went about doing good, and healing all that were oppressed of the devil; for God was with him.
- 5. Phil. 2:10 at, 11
 - at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of *things* in heaven, and *things* in earth, and *things* under the earth;
- And *that* every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ *is* Lord, to the glory of God the Father.
