Scriptural Selection

1. Romans 8:1, 5

- 1 *THERE* is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.
- 5 For they that are after the flesh do mind the things of the flesh; but they that are after the Spirit the things of the Spirit.

2. Mark 6:34 Jesus

- 34 Jesus, when he came out, saw much people, and was moved with compassion toward them, because they were as sheep not having a shepherd: and he began to teach them many things.

3. Mark 9:2-9 after

- 2 after six days Jesus taketh *with him* Peter, and James, and John, and leadeth them up into an high mountain apart by themselves: and he was transfigured before them.
- 3 And his raiment became shining, exceeding white as snow; so as no fuller on earth can white them.
- 4 And there appeared unto them Elias with Moses: and they were talking with Jesus.

- 8 And suddenly, when they had looked round about, they saw no man any more, save Jesus only with themselves.
- 9 And as they came down from the mountain, he charged them that they should tell no man what things they had seen, till the Son of man were risen from the dead.
4. Matt. 10:1 when, 16, 19 take, 20
- 1 when he had called unto *him* his twelve disciples, he gave them power *against* unclean spirits, to cast them out, and to heal all manner of sickness and all manner of disease.
- 16 ¶ Behold, I send you forth as sheep in the midst of wolves: be ye therefore wise as serpents, and harmless as doves.
- 19 take no thought how or what ye shall speak: for it shall be given you in that same hour what ye shall speak.
- 20 For it is not ye that speak, but the Spirit of your Father which speaketh in you.

5. Gal. 5:16, 22 1st the, 23, 25

- 16 *This* I say then, Walk in the Spirit, and ye shall not fulfil the lust of the flesh.
- 22 the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith,
- 23 Meekness, temperance: against such there is no law.
- 25 If we live in the Spirit, let us also walk in the Spirit.
