- 10 Create in me a clean heart, O God; and renew a right spirit within me.

- 13 ¶ Now when they saw the boldness of Peter and John, and perceived that they were unlearned and ignorant men, they marvelled; and they took knowledge of them, that they had been with Jesus.
- 14 And beholding the man which was healed standing with them, they could say nothing against it.
- 31 ¶ And when they had prayed, the place was shaken where they were assembled together; and they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and they spake the word of God with boldness.

#### 1. SH 561:32-3

John the Baptist prophesied the coming of the im-562:1 maculate Jesus, and John saw in those days the spiritual idea as the Messiah, who would baptize with the Holy

<sup>3</sup> Ghost, — divine Science.

#### 2. SH 588:7

**HOLY GHOST.** Divine Science; the development of eternal Life, Truth, and Love.

#### 3. SH 29:24-4

The Holy Ghost, or divine Spirit, overshadowed the pure sense of the Virgin-mother with the full recognition that being is Spirit. The Christ dwelt forever

- 27 an idea in the bosom of God, the divine Principle of the man Jesus, and woman perceived this spiritual idea, though at first faintly developed.
- 30 Man as the offspring of God, as the idea of Spirit, is the immortal evidence that Spirit is harmonious and man eternal. Jesus was the offspring of Mary's self-
- <sup>30:1</sup> conscious communion with God. Hence he could give a more spiritual idea of life than other men, and could

Spiritual idea revealed demonstrate the Science of Love — his Father or divine Principle.

#### 4. SH 23:12

- Rabbinical lore said: "He that taketh one doctrine, firm in faith, has the Holy Ghost dwelling in him." This preaching receives a strong rebuke in
- the Scripture, "Faith without works is dead."Faith, if it be mere belief, is as a pendulum swinging between nothing and something, having no fixity. Faith,
- 18 advanced to spiritual understanding, is the evidence gained from Spirit, which rebukes sin of every kind and establishes the claims of God.

### 5. SH 358:24-10

- <sup>24</sup> Sometimes it is said: "Rest assured that whatever effect Christian Scientists may have on the sick, comes through rousing within the sick a belief
- that in the removal of disease these healershave wonderful power, derived from the Holy Ghost."Is it likely that church-members have more faith in
- <sup>30</sup> some Christian Scientist, whom they have perhaps never seen and against whom they have been warned, than they have in their own accredited and orthodox
- <sup>359:1</sup> pastors, whom they have seen and have been taught to love and to trust?
- <sup>3</sup> Let any clergyman try to cure his friends by their faith in him. Will that faith heal them? Yet Scientists will take the same cases, and cures will follow.
- <sup>6</sup> Is this because the patients have more faith in the Scientist than in their pastor? I have healed infidels whose only objection to this method was, that I as a Chris-
- 9 tian Scientist believed in the Holy Spirit, while they, the patients, did not.

## 6. SH 359:14

The evi-

dence of the existence of Spirit, Soul, is palpable only to spiritual sense, and is not apparent to the material senses, which cognize only that which is the opposite of Spirit.

## 7. SH 43:3, 21-23

- 91 The magnitude of Jesus' work, his material disappearance before their eyes and his reappearance, all enabled the disciples to understand what Jesus had
- said. Heretofore they had only believed;now they understood. The advent of this understanding

is what is meant by the descent of the Holy Ghost, — that influx of divine Science which so illuminated the Pentecostal Day and is now repeating its ancient history.

Jesus rose higher in demonstration because of the cup of bitterness he drank. Human law had condemned him, but he was demonstrating divine Science.

#### 8. SH 46:25-9

Jesus was "the way;" that is, he marked the way for all men. In his final demonstration, called the ascen-

- 27 sion, which closed the earthly record of Jesus, he rose above the physical knowledge of his disciples, and the material senses saw him no more.
- <sup>30</sup> His students then received the Holy Ghost. By this is meant, that by all they had witnessed and suffered, they were roused to an enlarged understanding of divine Sci-
- 47:1 ence, even to the spiritual interpretation and discernment of Jesus' teachings and demonstrations, which gave them
- a faint conception of the Life which is God.
  They no longer measured man by material sense. After gaining the true idea of their glorified Master,
- 6 they became better healers, leaning no longer on matter, but on the divine Principle of their work. The influx of light was sudden. It was sometimes an overwhelming
- <sup>9</sup> power as on the Day of Pentecost.
- 9. SH 332:19 Jesus

Jesus demonstrated Christ; he proved that Christ is the divine idea of God — the Holy Ghost,

or Comforter, revealing the divine Principle,Love, and leading into all truth.

#### 10. SH 331:26-1

VII. Life, Truth, and Love constitute the triune Person

- 27 called God, that is, the triply divine Principle, Love. They represent a trinity in unity, three in one, — the same in essence, though multi-
- 30 form in office: God the Father-Mother; Christ the spiritual idea of sonship; divine Science or the Holy Comforter. These three express in divine Science the threefold, essen-
- 332:1 tial nature of the infinite.

#### 11. SH 330:11

- 18 I. God is infinite, the only Life, substance, Spirit, or
- Soul, the only intelligence of the universe, including man. Eye hath neither seen God nor His image and likeness. Neither God nor the perfect man

can be discerned by the material senses. The individuality of Spirit, or the infinite, is unknown, and thus a knowledge of it is left either to human conjecture or to the revelation of divine Science.

#### 12. SH 558:1-19

- 558:1 St. John writes, in the tenth chapter of his book of Revelation: —
- <sup>3</sup> And I saw another mighty angel come down from heaven, clothed with a cloud: and a rainbow was upon his head, and his face was as it were the sun, and his feet as pillars of
- <sup>6</sup> fire: and he had in his hand a little book open: and he set his right foot upon the sea, and his left foot on the earth.
- 9 This angel or message which comes from God, clothed with a cloud, prefigures divine Science. To mortal sense Science seems at first obscure, abstract, and
- dark; but a bright promise crowns its brow.When understood, it is Truth's prism and praise. When you look it fairly in the face, you can heal by its means,
- and it has for you a light above the sun, for God "is the light thereof." Its feet are pillars of fire, foundations of Truth and Love. It brings the baptism of the Holy
- 18 Ghost, whose flames of Truth were prophetically described by John the Baptist as consuming error.

#### 13. SH 497:5 We

We acknowledge and adore one supreme and in-

6 finite God. We acknowledge His Son, one Christ; the Holy Ghost or divine Comforter; and man in God's image and likeness.

#### 14. SH 496:15

- 15 Hold perpetually this thought, that it is the spiritual idea, the Holy Ghost and Christ, which enables you to demonstrate, with scientific certainty, the rule of healing,
- based upon its divine Principle, Love, underlying, overlying, and encompassing all true being.
