- 27 The eternal God *is thy* refuge, and underneath *are* the everlasting arms:  
 and he shall thrust out the enemy from before thee; and shall say, Destroy  
*them*.
- 28 Israel then shall dwell in safety alone:
- 29 Happy *art* thou, O Israel: who *is* like unto thee, O people saved by the  
 LORD, the shield of thy help, and who *is* the sword of thy excellency! and
