- 22 ¶ And straightway Jesus constrained his disciples to get into a ship, and to
go before him unto the other side, while he sent the multitudes away.
- 23 And when he had sent the multitudes away, he went up into a mountain
apart to pray: and when the evening was come, he was there alone.
- 24 But the ship was now in the midst of the sea, tossed with waves: for the
wind was contrary.
- 25 And in the fourth watch of the night Jesus went unto them, walking on the
sea.
- 26 And when the disciples saw him walking on the sea, they were troubled,
saying, It is a spirit; and they cried out for fear.
- 27 But straightway Jesus spake unto them, saying, Be of good cheer; it is I;
be not afraid.

10. John 2:19-22 Destroy

- 19 Destroy this temple, and in three days I will raise it up.
- 20 Then said the Jews, Forty and six years was this temple in building, and wilt thou rear it up in three days?
- 21 But he spake of the temple of his body.
- 22 When therefore he was risen from the dead, his disciples remembered that he had said this unto them; and they believed the scripture, and the word which Jesus had said.

11. Phil. 2:9-11 God

- 9 God also hath highly exalted him, and given him a name which is above every name:
- 10 That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of *things* in heaven, and *things* in earth, and *things* under the earth;

Science and Health with Key to the Scriptures by Mary Baker Eddy

1. SH 60:2-3

- Science inevitably lifts one's being higher in the scale of
3 harmony and happiness.

2. SH 95:30-32

- 30 Material sense does not unfold the facts of
existence; but spiritual sense lifts human
consciousness into eternal Truth.

3. SH 371:27-30

- The necessity for uplifting the race is father to
the fact that Mind can do it; for Mind can impart
purity instead of impurity, strength instead of weak-
30 ness, and health instead of disease.

4. SH 505:16-17

Spirit imparts the understanding which uplifts con-
sciousness and leads into all truth.

5. SH 259:6-11

- 6 In divine Science, man is the true image of God. The
divine nature was best expressed in Christ Jesus, who
threw upon mortals the truer reflection of God and lifted
9 their lives higher than their poor thought-models would
allow, — thoughts which presented man as fallen, sick,
sinning, and dying.

6. SH 497:20

5. We acknowledge that the crucifixion of Jesus and
21 his resurrection served to uplift faith to understand eter-
nal Life, even the allness of Soul, Spirit, and the noth-
ingness of matter.

7. SH 520:30

Spirit acts through the Science of Mind,
never causing man to till the ground, but making him
521:1 superior to the soil. Knowledge of this lifts man above
the sod, above earth and its environments, to conscious
3 spiritual harmony and eternal being.

8. SH 114:23-27

Christian Science explains all cause and effect as men-
24 tal, not physical. It lifts the veil of mystery from Soul and
body. It shows the scientific relation of man
to God, disentangles the interlaced ambiguities
27 of being, and sets free the imprisoned thought.

9. SH 147:14

Although this volume contains the complete Science of
15 Mind-healing, never believe that you can absorb the whole
meaning of the Science by a simple *perusal*
of this book. The book needs to be *studied*,

nation's belief. Pagan worship began with muscularity,
3 but the law of Sinai lifted thought into the
song of David. Moses advanced a nation to
the worship of God in Spirit instead of matter, and il-
6 lustrated the grand human capacities of being bestowed
by immortal Mind.

11. SH 235:7, 28-32

30 The teachers of schools and the readers in churches
should be selected with as direct reference to their
9 morals as to their learning or their correct
reading. Nurseries of character should be
strongly garrisoned with virtue. School-examinations are
12 one-sided; it is not so much academic education, as a
moral and spiritual culture, which lifts one higher. The
pure and uplifting thoughts of the teacher, constantly
15 imparted to pupils, will reach higher than the heavens of
astronomy; while the debased and unscrupulous mind,

though adorned with gems of scholarly attainment, will degrade the characters it should inform and elevate.

Clergymen, occupying the watchtowers of the world, should uplift the standard of Truth. They should so raise their hearers spiritually, that their listeners will love to grapple with a new, right idea and broaden their concepts.

Science. Through the uplifting and consecrating power
3 of divine Truth, they obtained a victory over the corpo-
real senses, a victory which Science alone can explain.

13. SH 175:9-12

9 What an abuse of natural beauty to say that a rose,
the smile of God, can produce suffering! The joy of its
presence, its beauty and fragrance, should uplift the
12 thought, and dissuade any sense of fear or fever.

14. SH 400:18-19

By lifting thought above error, or disease, and con-
tending persistently for truth, you destroy error.

15. SH 97:22-32

21 It
requires courage to utter truth; for the higher Truth
24 lifts her voice, the louder will error scream, until its in-
articulate sound is forever silenced in oblivion.

“He uttered His voice, the earth melted.” This Scrip-
27 ture indicates that all matter will disappear before the
supremacy of Spirit.

Christianity is again demonstrating the Life that is
30 Truth, and the Truth that is Life, by the apos-
tolic work of casting out error and healing the
sick.

16. SH 547:28-32

Inspired thought relinquishes a material, sensual, and
mortal theory of the universe, and adopts the spiritual and
30 immortal.

It is this spiritual perception of Scripture, which lifts
humanity out of disease and death and inspires faith.

17. SH 574:19-3

574:1 Note this, — that the
very message, or swift-winged thought, which poured

forth hatred and torment, brought also the experience which at last lifted the seer to behold the great city, the four equal sides of which were heaven-bestowed and heaven-bestowing.

Think of this, dear reader, for it will lift the sack-cloth from your eyes, and you will behold the soft-winged dove descending upon you. The very circumstance, which your suffering sense deems wrathful and afflictive, Love can make an angel entertained unawares. Then thought gently whispers: “Come hither! Arise from your false consciousness into the true sense of Love, and behold the Lamb’s wife, — Love wedded to its own spiritual idea.”

15 itself into purer desires, even into spiritual power and good-will to man.

19. SH 492:7-12

Being is holiness, harmony, immortality. It is already proved that a knowledge of this, even in small degree,
9 will uplift the physical and moral standard of mortals, will increase longevity, will purify and elevate character. Thus progress will finally destroy
12 all error, and bring immortality to light.
