1. SH 267:3-5 (to 1st .)

³ The offspring of God start not from matter or ephemeral dust. They are in and of Spirit, divine Mind, and so forever continue.

2. SH 325:26-29

The time cometh when

²⁷ the spiritual origin of man, the divine Science which ushered Jesus into human presence, will be understood and demonstrated.

3. SH 533:21-23, 30-5

²¹ Materiality, so obnoxious to God, is already found in the rapid deterioration of the bone and flesh which came from Adam to form Eve.

She has

already learned that corporeal sense is the serpent. Hence

- ^{534:1} she is first to abandon the belief in the material origin of man and to discern spiritual creation. This hereafter
- ³ enabled woman to be the mother of Jesus and to behold at the sepulchre the risen Saviour, who was soon to manifest the deathless man of God's creating.

4. SH 598:1-5

- ^{598:1} The Greek word for *wind* (*pneuma*) is used also for *spirit*, as in the passage in John's Gospel, the third chap-
- ter, where we read: "The wind [*pneuma*] bloweth where it listeth.... So is every one that is born of the Spirit

[pneuma]."

5. SH 262:27-28 (to 1st .)

²⁷ The foundation of mortal discord is a false sense of man's origin.

6. SH 63:5

In Science man is the offspring of Spirit. The beauti-

- ⁶ ful, good, and pure constitute his ancestry. His origin is not, like that of mortals, in brute instinct, nor does he pass through material conditions prior
- 9 to reaching intelligence. Spirit is his primitive and ultimate source of being; God is his Father, and Life is the law of his being.

7. SH 265:16

The senses represent birth as untimely and death as irresistible, as if man were a weed growing apace or a

- 18 flower withered by the sun and nipped by untimely frosts; but this is true only of a mortal, not of a man in God's image and likeness. The
- ²¹ truth of being is perennial, and the error is unreal and obsolete.

8. SH 61:14, 29

If some fortuitous circumstance places promising chil-

- dren in the arms of gross parents, often these beautiful children early droop and die, like tropical flowers born amid Alpine snows. If perchance
- they live to become parents in their turn, they may reproduce in their own helpless little ones the grosser traits of their ancestors. What hope of happiness, what noble
- ²¹ ambition, can inspire the child who inherits propensities that must either be overcome or reduce him to a loathsome wreck?

The formation of mortals must greatly improve to advance mankind. The scientific *morale* of marriage is

- 30 advance mankind. The scientific *morale* of marriage is spiritual unity. If the propagation of a higher human species is requisite to reach this goal, then its material con-
- 62:1 ditions can only be permitted for the purpose of generating. The fœtus must be kept mentally pure and the
- ³ period of gestation have the sanctity of virginity.

9. SH 178:8-17

- 12 Heredity is not a law. The remote cause or belief
- 9 of disease is not dangerous because of its priority and the connection of past mortal thoughts with present.

Propensities inherited The predisposing cause and the exciting cause are mental.

Perhaps an adult has a deformity produced prior to his birth by the fright of his mother. When wrested from human belief and based on Science or the divine Mind, to which all things are possible, that chronic case is not difficult to cure.

10. SH 272:19-25

It is the spiritualization of thought and Christianization of daily life, in contrast with the results of the ghastly farce

- of material existence; it is chastity and purity, in contrast with the downward tendencies and earthward gravitation of sensualism and impurity,
- 24 which really attest the divine origin and operation of Christian Science.

11. SH 305:27-29

Because man is the reflection of his Maker, he is not subject to birth, growth, maturity, decay.

12. SH 206:25-26

Can there be any birth or death for man, the spiritual image and likeness of God?

13. SH 244:13-14, 23-24

Man undergoing birth, maturity, and decay is like the beasts and vegetables, — subject to laws of decay. Man in Science is neither young nor old. He has

24 neither birth nor death.

14. SH 215:24-26

Mortal man is the antipode of immortal man in origin, in existence, and in his relation to God.

15. SH 250:7-11 (to 1st .)

- Spirit is the Ego which never dreams, but understands all things;
- 9 which never errs, and is ever conscious; which never believes, but knows; which is never born and never dies.

16. SH 288:31-1

The eternal Truth destroys what mortals seem to have learned from error, and man's real existence as a child ^{289:1} of God comes to light. Unspiritual contrasts

You may say that mortals are formed before they

- 30 think or know aught of their origin, and you may also ask how belief can affect a result which precedes the development of that belief. It can
- ^{554:1} only be replied, that Christian Science reveals what "eye hath not seen," even the cause of all that exists, for
- the universe, inclusive of man, is as eternal as God, who is its divine immortal Principle. There is no such thing as mortality, nor are there properly any mortal beings,
- 6 because being is immortal, like Deity, or, rather, being and Deity are inseparable.

19. SH 109:24-31

When a new spiritual idea is borne to earth, the prophetic Scripture of Isaiah is renewedly fulfilled: "Unto us a child is born, . . . and his name shall be

- 27 called Wonderful." Jesus once said of his lessons: "My doctrine is not mine, but His that sent me. If any man will do His will,
- 30 he shall know of the doctrine, whether it be of God, or whether I speak of myself." (John vii. 16, 17.)

20. SH 25:16-17

Jesus presented the ideal of God better than could any man whose origin was less spiritual.

21. SH 30:5-8, 11

Born of a woman, Jesus' advent in the flesh partook

- 6 partly of Mary's earthly condition, although he was endowed with the Christ, the divine Spirit, without measure. Had his origin and birth been wholly apart from mortal
- ¹² usage, Jesus would not have been appreciable to mortal mind as "the way."

22. SH 191:8

- 15 As a material, theoretical life-basis is found to be a
- 9 misapprehension of existence, the spiritual and divine Principle of man dawns upon human thought, and leads it to "where the young child was,"
- ¹² even to the birth of a new-old idea, to the spiritual sense of being and of what Life includes. Thus the whole

23. SH 127:26

Science is an emanation of

divine Mind, and is alone able to interpret God aright.
It has a spiritual, and not a material origin. It is a divine utterance, — the Comforter which leadeth into all truth.

24. SH 35:20-25

We can

- 21 unite with this church only as we are newborn of Spirit, as we reach the Life which is Truth and the Truth which is Life by bringing forth
- 24 the fruits of Love, casting out error and healing the sick.

25. SH 190:14

Human birth, growth, maturity, and decay are as the

- 15 grass springing from the soil with beautiful green blades, afterwards to wither and return to its native nothingness. This mortal seeming is temporal;
- it never merges into immortal being, but finally disappears, and immortal man, spiritual and eternal, is found to be the real man.

26. SH 557:18-21

Divine

²¹ never dying, but as coexistent with his creator.
