12:1 "The prayer of faith shall save the sick," says the Scripture. What is this healing prayer?

2. SH 1:1-4

3:1 The prayer that reforms the sinner and heals the

sick is an absolute faith that all things are possible to God, — a spiritual understanding of Him, an unselfed love.

3. SH 206:13-14

This prayer, governed by Science instead of the senses, heals the sick.

4. SH 16:2-5

16:1 The highest prayer

is not one of faith merely; it is demonstration. Such prayer heals sickness, and must destroy sin and death.

5. SH x:22-25

The divine Principle of healing is proved in the personal experience of any sincere seeker of Truth. Its

24 purpose is good, and its practice is safer and more potent than that of any other sanitary method.

6. SH viii:12-15

The question, What is Truth, is answered by demonstration, — by healing both disease and sin; and this demonstration shows that Christian healing con-

15 fers the most health and makes the best men.

To-day the healing power of Truth is widely demonstrated as an immanent, eternal Science, instead of a

of Mind by using material means, thus working against themselves and their prayers and denying man's Godgiven ability to demonstrate Mind's sacred power.

The physical healing of Christian Science results now, as in Jesus' time, from the operation of divine Principle, before which sin and disease lose their real-

- ity in human consciousness and disappear as naturally and as necessarily as darkness gives place to light and sin to reformation. Now, as then, these mighty works
- are not supernatural, but supremely natural. They are the sign of Immanuel, or "God with us," a divine influence ever present in human consciousness and re-

18 nothingness like dew before the morning sunshine.

13. SH 226:25-13

The lame, the deaf, the dumb, the blind, the sick, the sensual, the sinner, I wished to save from the slavery of

- 27 their own beliefs and from the educational systems of the Pharaohs, who to-day, as of yore, hold the children of Israel in bondage. I saw be-
- fore me the awful conflict, the Red Sea and the wilderness; but I pressed on through faith in God, trusting Truth, the strong deliverer, to guide me into the land
- 227:1 of Christian Science, where fetters fall and the rights of man are fully known and acknowledged.
- I saw that the law of mortal belief included all error, and that, even as oppressive laws are disputed and mortals are taught their right to freedom, so the
- 6 claims of the enslaving senses must be denied and superseded. The law of the divine Mind must end human bondage, or mortals will continue unaware
- of man's inalienable rights and in subjection to hopeless slavery, because some public teachers permit an ignorance of divine power, — an ignorance that
- is the foundation of continued bondage and of human suffering.

14. SH 227:21-6

- Christian Science raises the standard of liberty and cries: "Follow me! Escape from the bondage of sickness, sin, and death!" Jesus marked out the
- 24 way. Citizens of the world, accept the "glorious liberty of the children of God," and be free! This is your divine right. The illusion of material sense, not
- 27 divine law, has bound you, entangled your free limbs, crippled your capacities, enfeebled your body, and defaced the tablet of your being.
- 308:1 If God had instituted material laws to govern man, disobedience to which would have made man ill, Jesus would not have disregarded those laws by healing in

direct opposition to them and in defiance of all material conditions.

The transmission of disease or of certain idiosyncrasies of mortal mind would be impossible if this great fact of being were learned, — namely, that nothing inharmonious can enter being, for Life *is* God.

15. SH 228:20

If we follow the command of our Master, "Take no thought for your life," we shall never depend on bodily conditions, structure, or economy, but we shall be masters of the body, dictate its terms, and form and control it with

24 Truth.

16. SH 169:18

- Science not only reveals the origin of all disease as mental, but it also declares that all disease is cured by divine Mind. There can be no healing ex-
- 21 cept by this Mind, however much we trust a drug or any other means towards which human faith or endeavor is directed. It is mortal mind, not mat-
- 24 ter, which brings to the sick whatever good they may seem to receive from materiality. But the sick are never really healed except by means of the divine power.
- 27 Only the action of Truth, Life, and Love can give harmony.

17. SH 136:1-2

136:1 Jesus established his church and maintained his mission on a spiritual foundation of Christ-healing.

18. SH 31:12-13

First in the list of Christian duties, he taught his followers the healing power of Truth and Love.

19. SH 390:12, 29

- When the first symptoms of disease appear, dispute the testimony of the material senses with divine Science. Let your higher sense of justice destroy the false
- process of mortal opinions which you name law, and then you will not be confined to a sick-room nor laid upon a bed of suffering in payment of the last far-
- thing, the last penalty demanded by error. "Agree with thine adversary quickly, whiles thou art in the way with him." Suffer no claim of sin or of sickness to grow upon
- the thought. Dismiss it with an abiding conviction that it is illegitimate, because you know that God is no more the author of sickness than He is of sin. You have no
- 24 law of His to support the necessity either of sin or sickness, but you have divine authority for denying that necessity and healing the sick.

of disease with as powerful mental opposition as a legislator would employ to defeat the passage of an inhuman law. Rise in the conscious strength of the spirit of Truth to overthrow the plea of mortal mind, *alias* matter, arrayed against the supremacy of Spirit. Blot out the images of mortal thought and its beliefs in sickness and sin. Then, when thou art delivered to the judgment of Truth, Christ, the judge will say, "Thou art whole!"
