II Sam 22:29-33 thou

- 29 thou *art* my lamp, O LORD: and the LORD will lighten my darkness.
- 30 For by thee I have run through a troop: by my God have I leaped over a wall.
- 31 *As for* God, his way *is* perfect; the word of the LORD *is* tried: he *is* a buckler to all them that trust in him.
- 32 For who *is* God, save the LORD? and who *is* a rock, save our God?
- 33 God *is* my strength *and* power: And he maketh my way perfect.

II Chron 33:1-3, 10-13, 15

- 1 MANASSEH *was* twelve years old when he began to reign, and he reigned fifty and five years in Jerusalem:
- 2 But did *that which was* evil in the sight of the LORD, like unto the abominations of the heathen, whom the LORD had cast out before the children of Israel.
- 3 ¶ For he built again the high places which Hezekiah his father had broken down, and he reared up altars for Baalim, and made groves, and worshipped all the host of heaven, and served them.
- 10 And the LORD spake to Manasseh, and to his people: but they would not hearken.
- 11 ¶ Wherefore the LORD brought upon them the captains of the host of the king of Assyria, which took Manasseh among the thorns, and bound him with fetters, and carried him to Babylon.
- 12 And when he was in affliction, he besought the LORD his God, and humbled himself greatly before the God of his fathers,

- 13 And prayed unto him: and he was entreated of him, and heard his supplication, and brought him again to Jerusalem into his kingdom. Then Manasseh knew that the LORD he *was* God.
- 15 And he took away the strange gods, and the idol out of the house of the LORD, and all the altars that he had built in the mount of the house of the LORD, and in Jerusalem, and cast *them* out of the city.

- 18 thus saith the LORD that created the heavens; God himself that formed the earth and made it; he hath established it, he created it not in vain, he formed it to be inhabited: I *am* the LORD; and *there is* none else.
