2 Ezra the priest brought the law before the congregation both of men and women, and all that could hear with understanding, upon the first day of the seventh month.

give to friends the results of her Scriptural study, for
the Bible was her sole teacher; but these compositions
were crude, — the first steps of a child in the newly dis-
covered world of Spirit.

the Bible was my only textbook. The Scriptures were
illuminated; reason and revelation were recon-
ciled, and afterwards the truth of Christian

called miracles; so did Joshua, Elijah, and
Elisha. The Christian era was ushered in with signs and
9 wonders.

men), open the way for Christian Science to be
understood, and make the Bible the chart of life, where

out.

Christ's

discord; all is Life, and there is no death. Everything in God's universe expresses Him.

16. SH 358:9-11, 15

9 Christian Science, understood, coincides with the Scriptures, and sustains logically and demonstratively every point it presents. It presents the calm and clear verdict of Truth against error, uttered and illustrated by the prophets, by Jesus, by his apostles, as is recorded throughout the
18 Scriptures.
